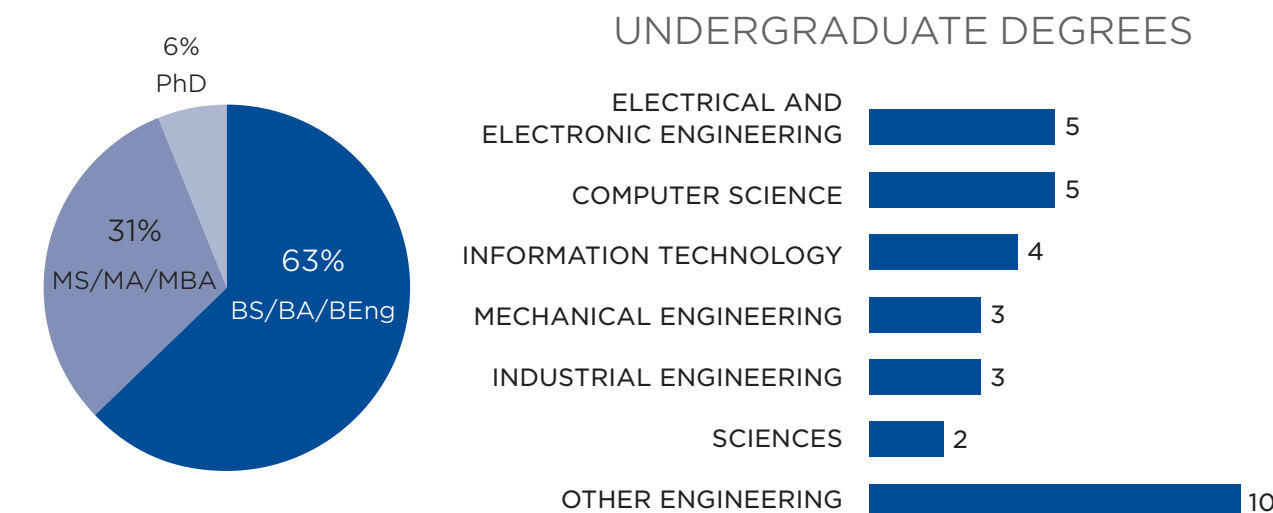

DEGREES PRIOR TO SDM OF GRADUATES SEEKING EMPLOYMENT

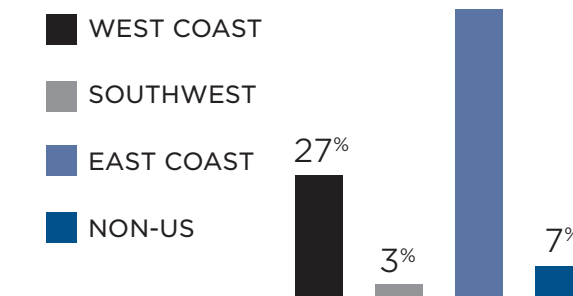

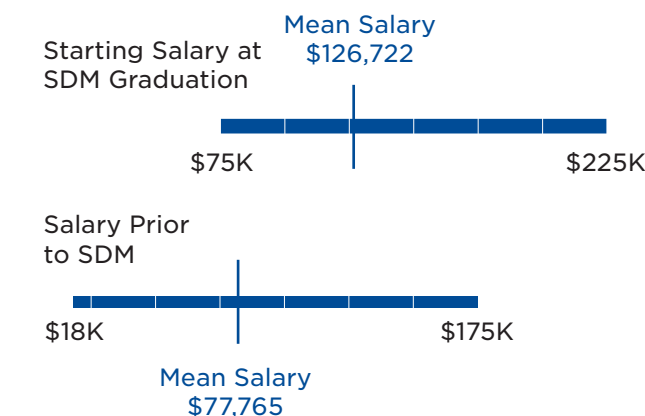


SALARY DATA
